

2026 HARVEST STOMP AUCTION TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. By bidding in Napa Valley Grapegrowers (NVG) and Napa Valley Farmworker Foundation's (FWF) Harvest STOMP® Auction, each bidder agrees to these auction terms and conditions ("Terms and Conditions"). You warrant that you are at least 21 and possess the legal capacity to participate in NVG and FWF auctions.
2. When you place a bid on an Auction item, you enter into a legally binding contract to purchase the item if you are the winning bidder. You are the winning bidder ("Purchaser") if your bid is the highest and is accepted. When you purchase a fixed-price item, you enter into a legally binding contract to purchase the item.
3. All sales are final. There will be no exchanges or refunds unless otherwise noted. All items are "as is." NVG/FWF has attempted to describe and catalog items correctly. Still, neither warrants nor represents and, in no event, shall be responsible for the correctness of the items' descriptions, genuineness, authorship, provenance, or condition. No statement made in this catalog, or made orally at the auction or elsewhere, shall be deemed such a warranty, representation, or assumption of liability.
4. The auction item value listed is an estimate of fair market value and is not warranted by NVG. Items have not been appraised unless so noted. Any tax-deductible contribution is limited to the excess of any money over the value of goods or services provided. Please consult your tax advisor about current tax regulations.

Sponsorships, live auction bids, reception fundraising, ticket revenue, and direct contributions support the Napa Valley Grapegrowers Foundation (NVG), a 501(c)(3) public charity. Only contributions to the Fund-a-Need directly benefit the Napa Valley Farmworker Foundation (FWF), also a 501(c)(3) public charity. Your tax receipt will reflect the organization that received your contribution.

5. Gratuities and tax may not be included. All dates shall be mutually agreeable to both the donor and the Purchaser. The auction lots do not include travel and shipping unless otherwise noted in the description.
6. Payment: After this auction, the credit card associated with your account will be automatically charged for the full price of your purchases. NVG accepts all major credit cards. If you would like to pay by cash, cashier's check, wire transfer, DAF, or personal check, you must notify us before 5:00 pm PT on August 22, 2026. California requires us to charge applicable taxes and fees on items auctioned at this event. Sales tax on all applicable items is included in the purchase price of Harvest STOMP Auction lots.
7. If a Purchaser fails to make payment when due, in addition to other remedies available to NVG/FWF by law, including, without limitation, the right to hold the Purchaser liable for the total Purchase Price. To the extent that the winning Bidder for any lot consists of more than one person or entity, each such person or entity is jointly and severally liable for all obligations of the Bidder, regardless of the title or capacity of such person or entity.

NVG/FWF also reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to rescind the sale and offer purchased auction lots to another bidder or to otherwise resell the lot(s) in a commercially reasonable manner, which may include a public or private sale.

8. **SHIPPING:** For winning bidders living within Napa County, we ask that you pick up your auction lots directly within 14 days after the auction closes on August 22 at approximately 9:30 pm PT at the NVG office, located at 625 Imperial Way, Suite 6 in Napa, California. For winning bidders living outside Napa County, shipping and insurance may be arranged at an additional cost. NVG Staff will reach out post-event to coordinate pick up or delivery of your bottle(s) and any other items associated with the purchase. Any purchaser who does not indicate a delivery preference within 14 days of the auction close will default to overnight shipment with full insurance billed to the purchaser's credit card on file. Insurance costs vary depending on the value of the lot and will be added to the final total. Full insurance is required on all wines shipped by NVG for Harvest STOMP winning bidders. Shipping will take place between October 1 and November 30, weather permitting. NVG is not responsible for any items damaged during shipping. The Purchaser is responsible for transporting spirits safely and lawfully and paying all necessary sales or use taxes in any chosen, final jurisdiction, if, when, or where applicable. It is the Purchaser's sole responsibility to insure the transport of all purchased spirits fully. International Purchasers are solely responsible for arranging the lawful export of purchased spirits and for all customs, duties, taxes, tariffs, or other charges that may arise therefrom.
9. NVG reserves the right to add, change, or withdraw items, without notice, to or from the auction.
